



Topical Scripture Resource

In our requests – we cry out to the Lord, IN CONFIDENCE, that He hears us and He responds. The following is a list of Scriptures that agree with God’s word on many life circumstances.

ANGER

“When you are angry, do not sin, and be sure to stop being angry before the end of the day. Do not give the devil a way to defeat you.” Ephesians 4:26-27

Example: Father, I find myself looking at the circumstances of my life and wondering why these things are happening. I see others in Scripture who seek you in their anxious times and I am encouraged as You show them Your presence, even in times of anger and injustice. You know how hard my life has been. This anger is a noise in my soul. It irritates my heart. Take this from me and light the dark place of anger with the Light of Jesus – The Light of the World Who suffered and endured the most unfair and unjust rejection – for me. I pray I suffer without anger – instead, I say with Stephen and Christ – Forgive the injustice for they don’t know what they are doing. Give me peace in this and a tender heart. I thank You that You see my struggle and You are able to give me peace. In the Name of Jesus – I pray.

In this example, we 1) reach out to the One Who can help you, 2) confess the sin of anger 3) acknowledge that your help is from Him 4) agree with His disdain of anger 5) thanks to the Him for His care 5) ask Him for help 6) glorify and honor Him with your trust.

ANXIETY

“Casting all of your anxieties on Him because He cares for you.” 1 Peter 5:7

“Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.” Philippians 4:6

CONTENTMENT

“Do not worry about anything, but pray and ask God for everything you need, always giving thanks. And God’s peace, which is so great we cannot understand it, will keep your hearts and minds in Christ

Jesus....I have learned to be satisfied with the things I have and with everything that happens. I know how to live when I am poor, and I know how to live when I have plenty. I have learned the secret of being happy at any time in everything that happens... I can do all things through Christ, because He gives me strength.” Philippians 4:6-7, 11-13

Example – Jehovah Jirah – (My God and Provider), I confess that I have had some disappointments in _____ . I also confess and praise You that Your grace is sufficient, that you are trustworthy for my future, that you are always with me and that while things may not be as I had hoped; my real and true hope is in You Lord. Father, I am thankful that you are in control of all circumstances. When I am disappointed, help me to turn to You and accept Your will, confident that You always have my best interest at heart.

COURAGE

“Don’t be afraid, because I have saved you. I have called you by name, and you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you. When you cross rivers, you will not be drown. When you walk through fire, you will not be burned, nor will the flames hurt you. This is because I, the LORD, am your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.” Isaiah 1-3

DEALING WITH THE PAST
